Attending the surgery

Currently our doors are locked to protect both patients and staff. If you have an appointment at the surgery or have been asked to come to the surgery please ring the doorbell, stand behind the 2m line on the floor and a member of the team will come to the door. You will be asked to wear gloves and a mask when you enter the surgery (these are provided).

Samples should ONLY be brought up if advised. You will be given a time to do this.

Requesting prescriptions

- Prescription requests can be made via email/e-consult online using patient access. We are
 unable to take medication requests over the phone. Scripts are being sent to a nominated
 pharmacy of your choice so that you will collect your meds directly from them.
- We are also recommending that patients sign up for Patient Access or use the NHS app to reorder repeat medications.
