Please allow a minimum of 10 working days for completion with the exceptions below. If your usual GP is away, it may take longer but you will be informed of this. Only for exceptional medical circumstances will requests for more urgent completion be accepted. Please do not ask or expect the doctor to complete paperwork during a consultation.

\*GPs will apply discretion as to whether these requests are appropriate and they have the necessary skills and knowledge to complete as requested

\*\*In view of the implementation of GDPR, access to medical records is free of charge (including reasonable printing/photocopying). Once the request is made, a copy of the data is to be provided within 28 days (excepting when additional information is required or for complex/numerous requests).

\*\*\*Insurance/employer medical reports: to completed within 28 days of receipt of payment being confirmed.

With regret we are unable to act as 'the counter signatory' on passport or driving license applications. It is recommended this be done by a friend, colleague, or neighbour – not a person known professionally.
